

CONFLICT MINERALS POLICY

At UEDA PLATING (M) SDN BHD, we are committed to conduct our business in responsible manner. As part of this commitment, we recognize the importance of addressing the issue of conflict minerals in our supply chain. Conflict minerals are minerals mined in conditions of armed conflict and human rights abuses, notably in the eastern provinces of Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries.

We implement our responsibilities through;

- Ensuring that the minerals for our process are sourced responsibly and ethically. This includes requesting suppliers to identify the source of minerals and working with suppliers to promote responsible sourcing practices
- Work closely with customer, suppliers to share information to promote a responsible mineral sourcing
- Periodically reviewing and updating our policies and documents, and supplier requirements to reflect evolving standards and best practices

By adhering to these principles, UEDA PLATING (M) SDN BHD aims to mitigate the risk of contributing to human rights abuses and armed conflict associated with the extraction and trade of conflict minerals.
